General Guidelines

- 1. All events will be conducted through virtual mode.
- 2. All events are open for schools across India.
- 3. One entry per event from schools will be accepted.
- 4. The Teacher Incharge of the participating schools must register for the events through google form link https://forms.gle/Qwqo4WjW6nfehLUC9 by 28.01.2021.
- 5. The registration forms will be considered valid only if it is complete in all aspects, and received via Google form link, no email will be accepted.
- 6. The participants are requested to follow the guidelines given event wise to qualify for the competition.
- 7. All the entries need to be submitted through link which will be provided for uploading entries (via WhatsApp groups) and the file name of video, ppt, picture, etc. should specify SCHOOL CODE provided to schools after registration.
- 8. The participant should introduce himself/herself in the beginning of the video using school code only.
- 9. Maximum duration for each entry should not exceed two minutes.
- 10. Decision of the jury will be final and binding and the result will be declared on March 6, 2021.
- 11. All the participants and position holders will be conferred E-certificates and the Champion School will receive Overall Championship Certificate.
- 12. Any entry found against the guidelines mentioned above shall be disqualified.
- 13. For further queries you may contact the respective event coordinators between 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM.
