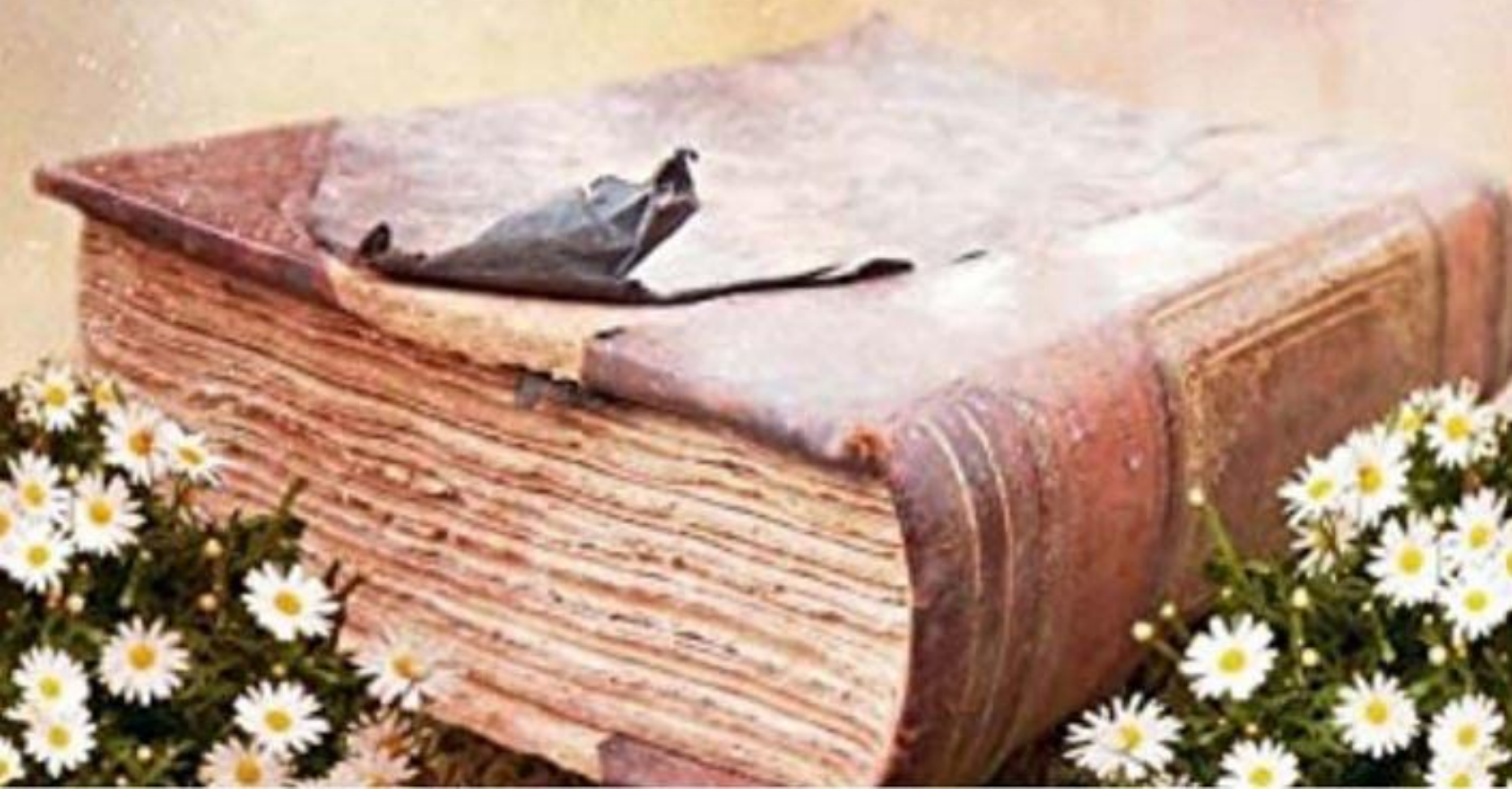

General Guidelines

- 1. All events will be conducted through virtual mode.*
- 2. All events are open for schools across India and abroad. One entry per event will be accepted from schools.*
- 3. The Teacher-in-Charge of the participating schools must register for the events through a given Google form link :-

- 4. The registration forms will be considered valid only if it is complete in all respects, and received via Google form link. No email entries will be accepted.*
- 5. The participants are requested to follow the guidelines furnished event-wise to qualify for the competition.*
- 6. All the entries should be submitted through the link, which will be provided for uploading entries (via WhatsApp groups) and the file name of video, PPT, picture, etc. should specify only the school code, provided to schools after registration. (Student's, teacher's or Name of the School should not be affixed with the School Code).*

8. The participant should introduce themselves in the beginning of the video, using school code only. Name or other specifications of the participants should not be revealed under any circumstance.

9. The time limit of each entry should not exceed the time limit mentioned event wise.

10. Decision of the jury will be final and binding and the result will be declared on August 11, 2021.

11. E-certificates will be conferred on all the participants and position holders.

12. Any entry found against the guidelines mentioned above shall stand disqualified.

13. For further queries, you may contact the respective event coordinators, between 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

14. Dress code – For events where costume is not required, students need to wear white T-Shirt with blue, black, or brown lowers.

15. Entries received beyond the due date will not be accepted.
